- Turn right on Carpenter Lane go 1.4 mi.
- Turn right into White Oak Park

• Continue through the park 1 mi. to Maple Grove (on right)

From Irwin PA Turnpike Exit 67 (Approx. 7.5 mi. or 14 min.)

• Take the Pittsburgh Rte 30 West ramp

• Proceed on Rte 30 west 5 mi. to Carpenter Lane (Sheetz on left)

- Turn left on Carpenter Lane go 1.4 mi.
- Turn right into White Oak Park
- Continue through the park 1 mi. to Maple Grove (on right)

From Monroeville PA Turnpike Exit 57 (Approx. 10 mi. or 23 min.)

- Take the Monroeville Bus Rte 22 ramp
- Merge onto Bus Rte 22 West
- Immediately get into the left lane
- Turn left on Rte 48 south (Mosside Blvd.) at Parkvale Bldg.
- Continue 5.8 mi. on Rte 48 to Rte 30
- Turn left on Rte 30 East go 1.7 mi. (Sheetz on right)
- Turn right on Carpenter Lane go 1.4 mi.
- Turn right into White Oak Park

• Continue through the park 1 mi. to Maple Grove (on right)
