

If you have already submitted a signed T&C, you **DO NOT** need to submit another one. However, recall that every person that will participate in a WPMC activity must have a signed T&C on record, so if you have changed spouses, or added another rider, they must also have a signed T&C in our records. We **DO NOT** need a **NEW** filled membership form each year, unless your info, like address, phone numbers, vehicle, or license has changed. Choose one of the following options to renew your membership. The Treasurer would appreciate if you would choose the Christmas party option, by bringing your signed check for \$30 and any required signed forms, to the Christmas party.

RENEW EARLY

Mail a signed check for \$30, and any required signed forms, to the address below. You will receive a new card and a receipt in the mail.

RENEW AT THE CHRISTMAS PARTY

The preferred option - At the Christmas Party check-in desk, where we want you to verify your info with our records, you will receive your name tags, meal choice card etc., and you can turn in your signed \$30 check and any required signed forms. We will **NOT** have forms available, so if you need new forms, bring them completely filled out. You can then quickly receive a new membership card and a receipt. This should be a simple process, so any line will move fast.

The first of October last year was really cold and we already had our first heavy frost, what a difference this year. The extended forecast for this October calls for well above normal temperatures. I don't know about you but Pat and I plan to spend as much time as we can cruising the hills and mountains of Western PA while the weather is still good. Fall has always been our favorite season and you know what comes after fall!!

If you have the urge to take a longer cruise for more than one day, I have a suggestion. If you haven't explored the DELMARVA Peninsula, then you should try it out!! It's only a qhalf day's drive to get there. Google it if you don't know where it is though if you have spent any time in the Northeast, you should be familiar with it. The Peninsula doesn't have the hills with the twisty roads we have around the 'Burgh but there are many open country roads you can explore off the main routes that take you through beautiful farmland. The side roads are lightly traveled, especially during the spring and fall seasons. Of course you also have the shorelines of the Delaware/Chesapeake Bays and the Atlantic Ocean to explore.

There are many small towns with great inns and B&B's. Pat and I just spent the better part of a week exploring this area of the northeast. We didn't have the Little Guy with us because we also wanted to do some biking. I have hauled our bikes on the back of the Little Guy but it really becomes a pain on longer, overnight trips. We do plan to go back with our Miata in the not too distant future for more "cruising time".

One of the overnight stops we made was the town of Chesapeake City, MD. It is only about 25 miles east of Baltimore, so it is on the northern end of the Peninsula and easy to get to. It is a historic village on the Chesapeake and Delaware Canal. The Canal has been around since the early 1800's and is the third busiest canal in the world, believe it or not!! It connects the lower Delaware River to the Chesapeake Bay. The town has a number of inns and B&B's to choose from plus some very good restaurants.

We stayed at The Ship Watch Inn right along the Canal. You can sit out on your balcony/porch and watch everything from jet skis to ocean freighters go by. You can practically reach out and touch them – what an experience!! This inn is not haunted (per Pat's request) but there are others that are if, that's your taste.




